

AlcoholEdu and Haven

AlcoholEdu is an online alcohol education and assessment tool that students are expected to complete before they arrive on campus in September. The program includes three surveys that measure students' alcohol-related attitudes and behaviors.

Haven is an online program addressing the critical issues of sexual assault, relationship violence, stalking, and sexual harassment. All students are expected to complete this online education and assessment tool before they arrive on campus in September.

The College cares about our students' health and wellbeing we feel that it is important that you have baseline knowledge of both alcohol and sexual misconduct. Being able to manage complicated situations as they arise and utilizing available campus resources as necessary are also important elements of our community standards.

How do I log in to AlcoholEdu and Haven?

AlcoholEdu and Haven must be taken online and can be accessed through the Incoming Students portal beginning July 10. You may also go to <http://www.everfi.com/login> and click Register. Under "Student/Learner," please enter the registration code: **gargoyle2017**, and click "Next" to create your account. **Please use your UChicago email address (i.e. sam3@uchicago.edu) when you register.**

When can I take AlcoholEdu and Haven?

Part I of both AlcoholEdu and Haven must be taken between July 10 and August 28. Part II of each module will be available in October. Both modules must be completed. Course registration will be affected if students do not complete these courses during the required time.

How much time should I allot to take AlcoholEdu and Haven?

The AlcoholEdu and Haven pre-matriculation assessment takes between 1.5 and 2.5 hours to complete in full. The post-matriculation test will be available online during the autumn quarter and will take approximately 15 minutes to complete.

Do I need to take the entire AlcoholEdu and Haven programs at once?

No, students will be able to create a user name (with a UChicago email address) for AlcoholEdu and Haven, save their work, and return at a later date.

How will my AlcoholEdu and Haven results be used?

All survey responses are strictly confidential; we will only receive information about the incoming class as a whole and will never see individual students' responses.

What if I do not have access to the Internet while AlcoholEdu and Haven are available?
