<p>Respond to the student's request for an accommodation.</p> <p>Determine a student's eligibility to receive reasonable accommodations (may take up to 3-4 weeks to receive a formal determination)</p> <p>Develop a plan for reasonable accommodations with the student</p> <p>Provide reasonable accommodations that enable students to access academic programs, services or activities</p>	<p>Self-identify to Student Disability Services (SDS)</p> <p>Provide appropriate and supporting evidence of the disability to SDS for review</p> <p>Follow the University's reasonable accommodation protocols</p> <p>Request reasonable accommodations in a timely manner</p>
